Intersect Systems Inc. Announces Law Enforcement Extension for Records Management Software

Dallas, Texas -- July 11, 2006 Intersect Systems Inc., a Texas-based developer of software for retention schedule development, document imaging, and records management, today announced a new Law Enforcement extension module for the company's Records Control and Management System (RCAMS).

In addition to maintaining records in accordance with an approved records control schedule, and providing for storage and retrieval of active and inactive records in accordance with that schedule, law enforcement agencies have the additional challenge of time-critical access to several categories of records.

"Law enforcement organizations have special records management needs," noted a spokesperson for Intersect Systems. "These include not only the need to locate critical documents, but the requirement to locate them quickly."

Time is critical for dispatch center responses, for instance. The State of Texas requires a response to a primary request from any law enforcement agency within ten minutes. For example, suppose an officer in a Texas city stops a suspicious vehicle with a registration from another Texas county, or with a driver whose address is in a different city. The law provides that the driver and vehicle can be detained for only ten minutes without a specific incident report or record that would justify an arrest or further investigation. When contacted by the dispatcher for the officer who stopped the vehicle, the dispatcher for the city or county in which the vehicle is registered has the challenge of determining within the ten-minute period whether a relevant incident report or other record exists, locating the record, and responding with the information to the requesting agency.

With the Law Enforcement module for RCAMS installed in a Dispatch Center, appropriate records and their locations are immediately available in the dispatch center. RCAMS and prepared queries replace printed lists. Search and query functions in RCAMS quickly pull up any matches on requested information entered by the dispatcher. RCAMS' stored query capability allows general queries to be pre-defined for several frequently accessed categories; the dispatcher can quickly select and run a relevant query, and then rapidly drill down further if necessary to locate any applicable incident report.

The Electronic Image Management capabilities of RCAMS and the Law Enforcement module also apply. This feature provides for indexing, retrieval, and viewing or printing of imaged documents. The objective is to further enhance a law enforcement agency's ability to quickly locate and display time-critical documents such as warrants and protective orders (also known as restraining orders).
