

## About Intersect Systems...

A Texas corporation, Intersect Systems Inc. was established in 1993 to develop and provide software for Texas Local Governments and state agencies to use in developing and maintaining records control schedules, and in managing their records. Intersect announced its original *Retention Schedule Manager* (RSM) and *Records Control and Management System* (RCAMS) software in 1994, and also began to publish the Texas state retention schedules in digital format.

Initial success and acceptance of the Intersect software resulted in a continuous development and enhancement effort to add more software features to the RSM and RCAMS applications, as well as development of additional applications for records management. The original RCAMS application is now in its 14<sup>th</sup> version. Interest from local governments and state agencies outside of Texas has resulted in expansion into other states. More recently, Intersect published *Clark's Encyclopedia of Records Retention* in digital format with associated software applications, expanding Intersect records management software applications into the commercial business world.

Today, Intersect software is used by state and local governments in five states in addition to Texas, including California and Florida. Publication of *Clark's Encyclopedia* and accompanying commercial versions of Intersect's retention schedule and records management applications have helped the company add commercial businesses to its growing customer base, including several Fortune 500 companies.

The company has experienced continuous growth since its founding, even during the generally less-than-favorable business climate in 2001–2002. The company continues to grow and expand its customer base, and has significantly expanded its range of software for records management applications. Important additions have been in the areas of editing and remote data access, and in the Image Management system introduced in 2003, for indexing and managing electronic records.

Intersect Systems is a privately held Texas corporation. The company has no long term or short term debt, and is still controlled and managed by its original founders.

Intersect Systems Inc. recently celebrated a milestone: the Summer of 2006 marked Intersect Systems' fourteenth year in business.
